











Dear Y6 Parents and Carers,

Below is information which we hope will be helpful to you for the remainder of the academic school year.

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>We will be looking at shape, in particular measuring angles using a protractor and identifying unknown angles in shapes.</p>  <p>We will then be moving on to geometry. In this topic we will look at translation and reflection as well as plotting co-ordinates on all four quadrants, moving on to problem solving. We will then undertake a project focused on themed problems.</p>  <p>Throughout our maths learning we will develop our problem solving and reasoning skills. We will also focus on developing our mathematical language.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p>  <p>In VIPERS, we will continue to develop our comprehension skills and answering questions focused on vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval and summarisation skills.</p>  <p>In our English lessons we will be using Shakespeare's 'Romeo and Juliet' as inspiration for our work. We will work towards writing our own play scripts. This will give us the opportunity to have lots of fun acting out play scripts and dramatic reconstructions of scenes. After this, we will revise and practise writing non-chronological reports.</p> <p>We will also be regularly practising our cursive handwriting.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>French</b></p> <p>Mademoiselle Cook will continue to teach us French every Wednesday.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Why did Britain win 'The Battle of Britain'?</b></p> <p>Our new topic focuses on investigating reasons why the Battle of Britain ended the way it did. We will look at reasons why the battle was waged in the first place and the many problems both sides had, along with the solutions they found.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Computing</b></p> <p>We will look at 3D modelling.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>PE</b></p> <p>Our focus will be outdoor summer sports, such as cricket and rounders.</p> <p>*Our PE days are <b>Monday</b> and <b>Thursday</b>. Children will need PE kit for both days. If these days change in a week the children will be informed.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>We will be focusing on the emotion: Worry. This will be with particular reference to worries our pupils may have as they prepare to move on.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RE</b></p> <p>We will be looking at Islam this half term: Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <p>We will start by learning all about the heart, circulation, and how the heart recovers after exercise.</p>  <p>We will then move on to look at different aspects of sports performance, such as playing surfaces, effective footwear and the best clothing for various sports.</p>  <p>Throughout our Science work we will continue to look at how to conduct an effective fair test.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Art</b></p> <p>Creating a variety of pieces influenced by different artists using a range of mediums and using charcoal, erasers and paint to depict a composition of special objects.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Special Projects</b></p> <p>We will be taking part in <b>Enterprise Week</b> during this half term. The children will spend time before the week thinking up ideas and preparing their activities. We will give parents further information nearer to the week itself.</p> <p>Our Year 6 children will be preparing their <b>Leavers' Assembly</b> ready to perform for parents and the rest of the school. Theme: 'The Ellis Has Talent'</p>
