Hate Crime

This is when somebody targets a victim because of their race, transgender identity, disability, religion or sexual orientation.

Knife Crime

This involves using, carrying or even just being with someone who has a knife.

You can get up to a four year sentence for just carrying any kind of knife without reason.

Signs of CCE

- New & unexplained items/money
- Frequent phone calls/text messages
- Frequently absent from school/home
- Becoming isolated & withdrawn
- Being angry, aggressive or violent

What to do if you suspect it

Talk to the police, or tell a trusted adult if you suspect yourself, or someone else is involved in CCE.

10 Criminally Responsible

In the eyes of the law, you are criminally responsible by the age of 10. This means you could get a criminal record for your actions along with a big fine

Consequences of Criminal Records

- Harder to get employment.
- Limited travel options available to you.
- Higher insurance premiums.
- Harder to be accepted for finance.

Bus Safety



Stand away from the edge of the kerb and put your hand out in plenty of time when the bus is coming



Have your pass, money or app ready before boarding as this helps save time



If seats are available please use them. If you do have to stand, please use the handrails. Remember to respect other passengers



Treat it like you would the family car. ABUSE IT YOU COULD LOSE IT.



When you are getting off the bus, ring the bell once and stay seated until the bus has stopped.



Remember if you have to cross the road, wait until the bus has pulled well away from the stop so you can see other traffic before using your road safety skills

Arson/Home Safety

What

Arson is the deliberate lighting of a fire causing harm or danger to others.

Consequences

Anyone found guilty of arson could be served with a caution or warning. Depending on the severity, they could also be taken to court, or even charged with manslaughter which carries a 25 year sentence.

Hoax Calls

Hoax calls to the emergency services can endanger the lives of others, and carry a fine of up to £5,000.

Fire Alarms

- One upstairs and one downstairs.
- They should be checked once per week.

Before Bedtime/Leaving

- Take everything off charge.
- Close all doors.
- Turn all electronics off, including games consoles
- Keep escape routes clear.
- Blow out any candles or naked flames.
