Dear Y3 Parents and Carers,

We hope you had a lovely half term, and hope the weather has now taken a turn for the better.

Below is information which we hope will be helpful to you.

Sensory Toys

We have noticed quite a few children are bringing in toys to school. If your child requires additional sensory items, we will discuss this with the parent and provide any additional items from school. Please don't allow your child to bring in putty/slime to school.

PE

Our PE days are **Monday** and **Tuesday**. The children will be covering cricket and dodgeball. The children will need appropriate kit in case we have outdoor PE. Please bring PE kits on a Monday and take them home on a Friday.

<u>Pumps</u>

We still have a few children in class without pumps or an appropriate change of shoes. (Alternative shoes for medical reasons are fine). As the weather is more changeable and it is very sludgy outside, any children who don't have a change of shoes will not be allowed out at break times as it is making our carpets and learning spaces very dirty.

Reading Books

Your child will bring home a reading book to enjoy and share with you at home. They can also read books or other reading materials of their choosing at home. Please record in their reading diary when they have read to an adult or maybe an older sibling. We ask that reading diaries are in your child's book bag every day. If reading diaries are filled then we will send home a second diary free of charge, however if it is lost then we ask that a new one is bought from the office at the cost of £1. Your child is welcome to change their book any day of the week when they have completed it, however, it is their responsibility to ensure books are changed regularly. Children should aim to read at home at least 3 times per week and reading raffle tickets will be awarded for reading.

Spelling books

We have changed our spelling scheme and will now be following the Read Write Inc scheme. Children have workbooks in school and will complete 10 minute spelling activities every day. They will have a range of spellings each week and will be tested on 6 of these on a Monday. New spellings will go home on a Monday so home spelling books will need to be in school. Spelling Shed can still be used as the children's spellings will be on there to practise. Please support your child in learning their spellings.

<u>Homework</u>

Children are encouraged to be regularly practising spellings and time tables online. As a school we have subscribed to websites to support the children with their learning. Seesaw will be used in school regularly and may be used for learning at home if the need arises. The

children have been given their individual logins for Seesaw, TT Rockstars and Spelling Shed. Please support your child with their learning on these platforms.

Children are expected to complete an English and Maths activity each week using Mirodo. These are very short tasks and will support children with their learning in school. Any children who don't complete their tasks will be invited to a homework club on a Thursday lunch time to support them to access this.

Spring 2 learning overview

<u>English</u>

We will start the half term by writing instructions using our VIPERS story 'The Worst Witch' by Jill Murphy. We will then write persuasive texts including adverts for holiday destinations.

In our VIPERS (reading) lessons, we will develop our comprehension skills whilst continuing reading 'The Worst Witch' by Jill Murphy.

<u>Maths</u>

Miss Cook will teach Number Monday to Wednesday. Miss Beresford will teach Shape, Space and Measure on Thursday and Friday. Children will complete arithmetic tasks for morning work on Seesaw and are welcome to complete additional ones in their own time at home.

In Number, we will learn about multiplication times tables and methods. In Shape, Space and Measure, we will be looking at money.

<u>Science</u>

Our Science learning will focus on forces and magnets.

Geography

In Geography, we will be answering the question 'Beyond the Magic Kingdom: What is the Sunshine State really like?'

<u>RE</u>

In RE, we will be exploring the question 'Why do Christians call the day that Jesus died Good Friday'.

<u> PE</u>

We will be focusing on cricket and dodgeball.

<u>Art</u>

In Art, we will be exploring and creating Ancient Egyptian art.

Computing

We will be learning about desktop publishing.

<u>French</u>

We will be learning about colours and using adjectives to describe.

<u>Music</u>

We will be using the theme of the Chinese New Year to explore pentatonic melodies and composition.

<u>PSHE</u>

We will be thinking about keeping and staying healthy. We will be particularly focussing on medicine and how to stay safe when talking this.
