

Summer 2 Learning Overview

English

We will be using the book 'Radiant Child, The Story of Young Artist Jean-Michel Basquiat' by Javaka Steptoe to inspire our writing. We be developing the skills to write an information leaflet about Jean-Michel Basquiat. We will focus on using a wide range of devices to build cohesion across paragraphs as well as using relative clauses beginning with who, which, where, when, whose, that or an omitted relative pronoun. In addition to this, we will be linking ideas using tense choices and using adverbs to indicate degrees of possibility.

In our reading lessons, we will continue to develop our comprehension skills while reading a selection of short stories and extracts. Our fluency lessons will utilise 'Dreambox Reading Plus'.

As a class, we will also continue to enjoy sharing the book 'The Last Wild' by Piers Torday.

Maths

We will begin by learning about decimals, this will include: adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing decimals. We will then be learning about negative numbers and counting back through zero in different steps. Y5 will also be learning about different types of measure and how to convert between metric and imperial measurements. We will then learn about measuring volume and capacity.

Science

In Science, we will continue to learn about changes and reproduction. We will then be consolidating our knowledge.

History

In history, we will be exploring the question 'What is the legacy of the Ancient Greek Civilisation?'

RE

In RE, we will be exploring the question 'What matters most to Humanists and Christians?'
